RELATING TO UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII RULEMAKING.

Substitutes the rulemaking requirements of Chapter 91, HRS, for the adoption of certain University of Hawaii policies with the open public

meeting requirements of chapter 92, HRS.

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RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. HED, FIN HB 902 Appropriates general funds for 6.0 FTE positions for the UH Status Pamantasan Council to promote access and diversity, including for programs and policies related to Philippine courses and Filipino students. **HB 24** RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII. HED, FIN Requires the Board of Regents of the University of Hawaii to develop Status procedures for the full utilization of university facilities. Requires the administration of the different UH campuses to collect and report data relating to facilities utilization. Prohibits the UH Board of Regents from approving the construction of a new university building until a public hearing is held to discuss facility utilization and cost. RELATING TO TAXATION. HED, FIN HB 128 Establishes a college savings program income tax credit. Status
