

RELATING TO INFORMATION CHARGING.

JUD

(SSCR616) **Status**

Authorizes all class B and C felony charges to be instituted by written

information subject to specified exceptions. Takes effect on 1/7/2059.

(SD1)

SB 1163, SD1

(SSCR854) Status

RELATING TO AERONAUTICS.

JUD

Replaces criminal penalties for certain airport offenses addressed in the laws relating to aeronautics or in certain administrative rules or orders issued pursuant thereto, with a civil penalty. Takes effect on 1/7/2059.

DECISION MAKING TO FOLLOW

Persons wishing to offer comments should submit testimony at least 24 hours prior to the hearing. Testimony should
