Status

Phases out the county allocation of transient accommodations tax revenues over a 3-year period. Implements new income tax brackets and rates over a 3-year period. Doubles the amount of the personal exemption. Places limitations on claims for itemized tax deductions.

HB 317 Status RELATING TO THE TRANSIENT ACCOMMODATIONS TAX.

Adjusts allocation of transient accommodations tax revenues to the tourism special fund for inflation. Adjusts allocation to the

tourism special fund for inflation. Adjusts allocation to the counties to equal 45% of the amount of revenues remaining after

all other allocations are made.
