<u>SB 1146, SD1</u> (SSCR285) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO SCHOOL IMPACT FEES. Exempts housing developments reserved for persons or families with incomes up to eighty per cent of the area median income located on the island of Oahu from school impact fee requirements. (SD1)	HOU/EDU, WAM
<u>SB 612, SD1</u> (SSCR45) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO AGRICULTURE. Appropriates funds to the Department of Agriculture for the feed developer grant program and reimbursements to qualified producers for feed costs.	AEN, WAM
<u>SB 249, SD1</u> (<u>SSCR185)</u> <u>Status &</u> <u>Testimony</u>	RELATING TO RETIREMENT. Provides that a member of the employees' retirement system who first earned credited service as a judge after June 30, 2017, and has at least ten years of credited service and attained age sixty, or has at least twenty-five years of credited service and has attained age fifty-five is eligible to receive a pension after retirement. Reduces the percentage of average final compensation used to calculate the retirement allowance for a member who first earned credited service as a judge after June 30, 2017, to two per cent. (SD1)	JDL, WAM
<u>SB 410, SD1</u> (SSCR250) Status & Testimony	RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING. Clarifies the allowable scope of collective bargaining negotiations regarding the rights and obligations of a public employer. Takes effect 1/7/2059. (SD1)	JDL, WAM
