The Department of Transportation (DOT) supports this bill:

In SECTION 2 of this Bill, the DOT recommends an amount of \$2,000,000 to be appropriated in Fiscal Year 2017-2018. The appropriation amount will be used to design and construct a westbound shoulder lane between the Kunia/Waipahu/Ewa interchange and the Kualakai Parkway interchange providing there are minimal or no upgrades or improvements to the existing highway facilities.
