## In consideration of HOUSE BILL 1457 RELATING TO AQUATIC LIFE

House Bill 1457 would require the Division of Aquatic Resources of the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) to promote education about nearshore reef wildlife and to develop a comprehensive plan, programs, and policies for its sustainable management. **The Department appreciates the intent of this measure to support a plan for sustainable management, but has concerns about other parts of the measure.** 

The Department supports education about reef life, but we would face many challenges to achieving the goals described. The Department currently does not have a permanent state-funded position on Oahu to provide this education to the public. The position was eliminated in the mid-1990s and despite repeated attempts to restore it, we have not been successful. The Department has started to develop a Statewide Aquatic Resources Management Plan, as well as, developing a plan for combating coral bleaching and improving reef health, pursuant to the Governor's 30x30 initiative. A plan for sustainable management of the marine resources would be a welcome addition.

While the Department respectfully disagrees with the bills characterization of unsustainable aquarium collecting, we do recognize the need to do more to better manage the State's resources. Plans are just one part of a larger effort to effectively manage these resources. Funding and manpower will be needed to develop the plan, gather the necessary scientific information for decision-making, and implement the plan.

More specifically, the parts of the bill that the Department is concerned about include determining what "historically naturally occurring levels" are. Also, the Department is unclear what subsections (c) and (d) mean. Why is there a special condition for "designated limited-entry areas" in subsection

(c) and where are these? Why does subsection (d) prevent the Department from not including the taking of fish for human consumption in our management programs?

Aloha Chair Ing and Committee members,

We appreciate and support the intent of HB1457, however we believe it should be made clear that it only applies to the marine aquarium trade. Everyone needs to eat – no one needs an aquarium fish. Placing limits on subsistence fishers while allowing the marine aquarium trade – which captures juvenile/undersize wildlife for personal aquariums on the mainland – to diminish and deplete populations of reef fish and other essential organisms is not compatible with Hawaii's values or good natural resource management.

We urge you to consider a complete moratorium on the marine aquarium trade until its numerous environmental, cultural, and ethical issues are resolved by the legislature. The DLNR is already overburdened and underfunded, and showing a strong bias in support of this trade, has long ignored its mandate and broad, clear, statutory authority to protect our natural resources. Note the low bar for strong action set by the legislature in HRS 190-3 for rules adopted by DLNR which "**may** prohibit activities that **may** *disturb*, *degrade*, *or alter* the marine environment."

For decades the marine aquarium trade has been allowed to substantially disturb, degrade and alter Hawaii's reefs to supply our wildlife to mainland aquarium hobbyists.

- Hawaii reefs are a public trust with significant socio-economic and cultural value.
  NOAA study sets annual value at \$34 billion.
- Millions of reef creatures are missing where aquarium collecting occurs.
- Heavily targeted species are down 50 90% on Oahu and Hawaii Island.
  - Many are herbivores, critically important to coral reef health.
- Aquarium trade effects are readily apparent on nearly all Hawaii reefs.
- Value and lost revenue is estimated in the hundreds of millions annually.
- Compromised reefs are a loss to all Hawaii people, while benefiting 50 full-time collectors, statewide. 20 more collectors work part time.
  - Reported annual landings are \$2 million gross.
  - Program administration and enforcement needs far exceed state revenues.
- Reef wildlife suffers from serious injury, mutilation, and starvation in capture and transport, contributing to early deaths and driving demand for replacements.
- A vast majority of Hawaii residents voice strong opposition to the aquarium trade, citing environmental, cultural and animal cruelty concerns.

- Some long-time DAR staffers consistently dismiss info/data exposing AQ negative impacts and major statewide calls to address the issues.
- In 2014, DARs administrator resigned, after just 14 months on the job, in part over this issue and the divisions political wrangling, lack of science-based rule-making, and consistent dismissal of stakeholder concerns.

We urge you to place a moratorium on the marine aquarium trade in order to <u>remedy</u> the disturbed, degraded and altered reefs that have resulted from their practices, <u>restore</u> abundance to Hawaii reefs, end wildlife abuse, and address culturally insensitive practices.

Dear Members of the Ocean, Marine Resources, & Hawaiian Affairs Committee,

Thank you for your consideration of the impacts of aquarium trade in Hawai'i. I am writing in support of HB 1457. Protecting the marine resources of Hawai'i should be a priority for a state whose critical economic tourism industry depends upon them. In this letter I will share data and findings from a recent piece of research I have conducted focusing on a testimony analysis of all 1,652 testimonies submitted for HB 873 in 2015. After removing duplicate testimony, there were a total of 1,455 usable testimonies. This research was presented at an academic conference in October of 2016, and was invited to be part of a special issue journal. The research and findings have since been submitted as a complete manuscript to *Tourism Geographies*, and are currently under peer review. In this letter I will summarize the research findings in attempt to broaden the debate on the importance of the state's marine resources.

This research demonstrated ten emergent themes from the data: sustainability, regulations, legislation (bill quality), economy, user conflict, social benefit, environment, animal welfare, extractive resource use, and culture. There were thematic overlaps in nine of the ten themes from the two positions on the bill (support and oppose). Culture was only referenced by supporters of HB 873. For brevity, I will address only two of the themes in this letter, economy and culture. The findings showed that stakeholder groups must be carefully considered. A previously overlooked group has been tourists as stakeholders in the marine resources. Understanding this stakeholder group should be prioritized as tourism is a critical industry to the state. Spatial demographic data revealed that marine resource user groups extend well outside of Hawai'i, especially for the supporters (those in favor of further regulating and/or banning the aquarium trade) (see Table 1). Support testimony came from nearly every continent and was widely distributed across the USA. This compares to the opposition who was representation was mostly localized to Hawai'i. Monetarily, tourism sales are estimated annually at \$25.2 billion (HTA, 2016), while the aquarium industry has been valued at \$3.2 million (Hawaii Coral Reef Initiative, N.D.). This discrepancy in economic value and impact demonstrates an urgent need to better understand the potentially detrimental impact of the aquarium trade on the state's tourism industry.

Another interesting finding from the research was the reference to Hawaiian culture. Hawai'i is unique, not only geographically, but also culturally. Hawai'i is known for its "Aloha" spirit (Mak, 2015). Culture emerged *only* from supporters' comments. The concept of pono, or righteousness, is commonly discussed and applied in Hawai'i (see Tissot, 2005) and has been used at a community level to successfully enact management practices for the marine environment in the absence of formal rules (Friedlander, Shackeroof, & Kittinger, 2013). In pre-contact Hawai'i, island societies developed and successfully followed complex and effective systems for marine resources management (see Friedlander, Shackeroof, & Kittinger, 2013). As stated by the supporters, of whom some were Native Hawaiian Practitioners, aquarium collection is not a native Hawaiian practice. Culture was not mentioned by the opposition. It is unclear if this element was simply overlooked or purposely avoided. Thus, the description of Tissot (2005), regarding a "classic conflict between the Judeo-Christian worldview that resources are for our use (i.e., the Garden of Eden) and the Hawaiian philosophy of mālama 'āina (caring for the land)" is applicable (p. 89).

As a general summary on the research, the findings revealed that supporters prioritized the social benefit of the collective resource, while the opposition viewed the industry as sustainable and well regulated in its current

state. It is, without doubt, known that healthy reef ecosystems would benefit all marine resource users. However, due to the complexity of the marine ecosystems, the mobility of fish, and other anthropogenic variables (e.g., underreporting, run-off, climate change), limiting the necessary variables to understand the specific impact of the aquarium trade will continue to be difficult. The data showed supporters as having a repetitive concern for the health of the reef ecosystem, identifying the ocean as a social resource worthy of protection. Alternatively, the opposition were concerned of the affects of further regulations on the aquarium industry (e.g., detrimental to *personal* livelihoods and freedoms). If Hawai'i is to remain the "Paradise of the Pacific" (see Mak, 2015), rather than a last-chance tourist destination, urgent attention to the health of the marine resources is needed.

Please pass HB 1457.

Aloha Chair Ing and OMH Committee Members,

I am a scientist and have been working on sustainability issues all my life, most recently on fishery improvement projects. I got certified as Scuba Instructor in Hawaii and during my more than 600 dives around the Hawaiian Islands, many times equipped with my UW camera, I learned even more to appreciate the abundance of our reefs.

Reefs are already increasingly threatened by factors like global warming, ocean acidification, and land-based pollution. In addition, reef wildlife, primarily herbivores are being removed in unlimited numbers for aquarium purposes. Tangs or surgeonfishes are proven to be vital for reef balance, reef resilience and recovery as they prevent excess algae growth.

The targeted wildlife is juvenile Yellow Tangs which are more susceptible to cumulative trauma, like injuries, stress, starvation, toxic chemicals, and poor water conditions during a long and complex supply chain. Many die and to offset the losses, more fish are taken. Reported landings of 2010 are 990 000 with catch report compliance low and regulations unenforced. The removal of wildlife impacts the health of our reefs.

Our reefs are imperative not only for Hawaiian culture and values but also for one of the state's largest industries, tourism. The economic value of healthy reefs for the local people by far surpasses the value of a trade that removes wildlife in unlimited numbers and for free and serves an off-island entertainment industry. It is in contrast to our Aloha spirit and not pono.

Food fisheries in Hawai'i are managed by catch quota, monitoring protocol and mandatory dealer reports. Other reef wildlife is protected by law like corals, as it is unlawful to break, damage or take corals from Hawaiian waters.

I support bill HB 1457 to ensure a sustainable future for Hawaii reefs; end new aquarium permits with a moratorium on existing permits pending a comprehensive plan for sustainable management.

Before arriving on Maui, I traveled the world and also ended up living long-term in 6 different countries- fantastic scuba diving employment opportunities were the reason (lucky me!). From my first dive where I grew up- a freshwater Michigan Lake- to raging oceans in the Indo Pacific to 2 mile deep trenches in the Gulf of Agaba, I have been lucky enough to experience our water world that few have. Because of these amazing opportunities, I believe I understand the needs of the reefs and eco-systems of the worlds oceans, especially Hawaii. (I produced a documentary about Hawaii's near-shore reefs- 2005 - Oasis of the Pacific: Time is Running Out). Thank you in advance for choosing to act on this information in a way to help change history. Yes, I do believe a decision regarding the following, can change history. I beleive an immediate moratorium on ALL aquarium trade activities are crucial to the health of all of Hawaii's near shore waters. Please consider doing all in your power to stop the extraction of reef wildlife from Maui county. No matter legal or not, taking ANY of the critters from this day forward could be the nail in the coffin for our reefs! Please go snorkel and check it out for yourselves! The reefs are in peril! ALL extraction from the near-shore waters of Maui county needs to stop now if our reefs are to survive! Please, please make this a priority. The last time I was there was almost 20 years ago (lived and worked as a divemaster in Amed for 6 mo's). Today, the reefs are not as pristine as they once were (unfortunately the plastic pollution and the sheer number of people using sewer systems is an obvious issue) but they are still healthy and literally teeming with fish and other critters! Snorkeling at 'Ahihi-Kina'u Reserve- a 100% notake, pretected area here in Makena- is such a contrast to how it was 15 years ago! The reefs are in bad shape- too much is algae covered and rarely do you see any really large fish. Plus I remember observing large schools of juvenile bluefin trevallys cruising the reefs on every dive. There was also much more diversity e.g. lots of unicorn fish and several different kinds of wrasse. It wasn't unusual to see a very large great barracuda or a couple of white-tip reef sharks just hanging out at about 25 feet. Now it really isn't that much different than Kam Point. It is obvious to me what is happening and it is unconscionable! The aquarium trade is literally raping our near-shore waters! 98% of saltwater aquarium fish are WILD CAUGHT! PLEASE get educated and stop supporting the aquarium trade. If you think it's horrible for the whales and dolphins to be trapped and subdued and enslaved in tanks for amusement, you're on the right track. The reef critters deserve to live out their lives in their homes as well (not to mention the fact that none of us will live if the reefs die- the ocean herself will perish)."
