#### In consideration of HB592 HD1 RELATING TO ENERGY.

Chairs Luke, Vice Chair Cullen, and Members of the Committee on Finance.

The High Technology Development Corporation (HTDC) **supports** HB592 HD1 that extends the sunset date of the Alternate Energy Research and Development Pilot Project to June 30, 2019 and appropriates funds for the Project.

As part of HTDC's vision to create 80,000 new innovation jobs in Hawaii earning \$80,000 or more by 2030, HTDC supports initiatives aimed at promoting technology and innovation jobs.

In FY16, the first year of the program, HTDC awarded \$1 million to 3 companies who secured \$11.3 million of federal funding from the Office of Naval Research for alternative energy projects. In FY17 HTDC anticipates awarding all of the \$1 million fiscal year 2016-2017 appropriated funds. HTDC believes the program supports the growth of companies with innovative renewable energy technologies in the State and moves Hawaii closer to its clean energy goal of 100 percent renewable energy by 2045.

We respectfully request correction of the defective effective date. We support this initiative as long as it does not replace our priorities requested in the Executive Budget.
