Aloha Chair Creagan, Vice Chair DeCoite, and Members of the Committee:

I am Randy Cabral, President of the Hawaii Farm Bureau (HFB). Organized since 1948, the HFB is comprised of 1,900 farm family members statewide, and serves as Hawaii's voice of agriculture to protect, advocate and advance the social, economic and educational interests of our diverse agricultural community.

Hawaii Farm Bureau **strongly supports HB 891**, requiring the Department of Agriculture to develop an implementation plan to increase local food production.

Many studies have been conducted (e.g. Increased Food Security and Food Self Sufficiency Strategy, October 2012, DBEDT and HDOA) that suggest strategies for increased food production.

Increased food production requires all types of agriculture. We have seen invasive species hitchhike on ornamentals cause havoc on local vegetables. Increasing our local floriculture industry is equally important to expanded food production.

Vermont has a program called Farm to Plate – a comprehensive strategy to increase agriculture in the State. It started in 2009 with authorizing legislation and has provided a report to the Legislature annually, showing a gradual increase in agricultural production and how it is growing Vermont's economy. Some changes will be needed but a working model is available.

HFB respectfully requests your strong support of this measure. A roadmap providing a common goal to improve Hawaii's agriculture is needed.
