SENATE BILL NO. 226 RELATING TO INDUSTRIAL HEMP

Thank for the opportunity to testify on Senate Bill 226 which proposes to appropriate funds for one full-time equivalent program coordinator and one full-time equivalent inspector position for the industrial hemp pilot program for the next biennium. The department supports this bill and requests that it be amended to allow the funds to also be expended to administer the program.

Act 228, SLH 2016 pertaining to the industrial hemp pilot program only appropriated funds for these positions for fiscal year 2016-2017. The department is currently awaiting approval from the Governor to conduct public hearing on the proposed administrative rules to Act 228. The department will need funding for these positions and administrative costs to carry out the activities of this program.

Aloha Chair Gabbard, Vice Chair Riviere, and Members of the Committee:

I am Randy Cabral, President of the Hawaii Farm Bureau (HFB). Organized since 1948, the HFB is comprised of 1,900 farm family members statewide, and serves as Hawaii's voice of agriculture to protect, advocate and advance the social, economic and educational interests of our diverse agricultural community.

**The Hawaii Farm Bureau supports SB 226**, providing funding for staffing and operations of the Hawaii industrial hemp program.

Industrial hemp provides an opportunity for our farmers to expand their production into new areas. The positions proposed are important to the success of the program. Current Hawaii Statute states:

**[§141-35]** Approved seed cultivars. (a) Industrial hemp shall be grown only if it is on the list of approved seed cultivars. The board may from time to time add or remove any seed cultivar from the list if the cultivar is found to be noncompliant with this part.

(b) The list of approved seed cultivars shall include the following:

(1) Industrial hemp seed cultivars that have been certified by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development; and

(2) Hawaii varieties of industrial hemp seed cultivars that have been certified by the board. [L 2016, c 228, pt of §2]

Identification of industrial hemp varieties that can be grown will require resources. This measure will address this need.
