My name is James E. Coon and I am speaking is strong support of SB422, SD1.

I am speaking as a citizen and a grandparent in favor of the intent of this bill which gives grandparents some potential visitation rights. I do believe that the bill as written still makes it very difficult for grandparents to prevail at a hearing to exercise their visitation rights because of the stringent procedures in order for the these visitation rights to be awarded. The threshold of a preponderance of evidence countered by a rebuttable presumption that a parent's decision regarding grandparent visitation still appears to make it very difficult for grandparents to have that right.

A reduction of the "preponderance of the evidence" to "reasonable evidence" might ensure grandparents visitation rights be respected as it relates to the wellbeing of the child.
