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Testimony COMMENTING on SB0538 RELATING TO CARE FACILITY INSPECTIONS.

Fiscal Implications: S.B. 538 appropriates an unspecified amount of general revenures to 1 2 enable the Department of Health to post care facility inspection reports on its website, pursuant 3 to Act 213, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013. Included in Governor's biennium budget package is a request for one (1) permanent, civil service, full time equivalent (FTE) and position funding of 4 5 \$13,566 for FY18 and \$27,132 for FY19 and beyond. 6 Department Testimony: The Department appreciates the intent of this bill and asks the members of the committee to support the Governor's budget package which includes a full-time 7 8 permanent civil service position and funding to perform the activities identified in this bill. 9 This bill provides unspecified FTEs and unspecified funds but only for the upcoming fiscal biennium. 10 The Governor's budget package includes one (1) FTE and funding for the Office of 11 Health Care Assurance and it would establish in the Department's base budget the position and 12 13 funding for years beyond the upcoming fiscal biennium. 14 The position would enable the Department to meet the requirements of Act 213, SLH 2013, as codified in Section 321-1.8 HRS to provide online access by the public of useful 15 16 information on licensed care homes.
