SB 624 – RELATING TO AGRICULTURE

Chair Gabbard, Vice Chair Riviere, and members of the Senate Committee on Agriculture and Environment:

Thank you for the opportunity to offer <u>comments</u> on SB 624, which requires the board of agriculture, in cooperation with the office of the governor, to develop a strategic plan to double local food production and exports by 2020; and requires the board of agriculture to submit a report to the legislature prior to the regular session of 2018 in order to codify the strategic plan and benchmarks.

The University of Hawai'i fully supports the Governor's goal of doubling local food production. As a member of the Board of Agriculture, we recognize the need for careful and rapid planning to achieve this goal. In October 2012, the Office of Planning issued the "Increased Food Security and Food Self-Sufficiency Strategy," part of a three-volume report by a multi-agency steering committee for food security and self-sufficiency. The strategy included specific recommendations to move Hawai'i forward in food security, and away from providing only 11% of our own food. We believe that this report would be useful as a basis for the specific planning effort requested in SB 624.

However, in order to collect the necessary data and information, and establish benchmarks, within the timeframe requested in SB 624, an intensive targeted effort by dedicated contracted personnel will be necessary. Thus, in order to accomplish the objectives of SB 624, we believe that an appropriation of funds to the Department of Agriculture should be included for this purpose. We would defer to the Department of Agriculture on fiscal details.

SENATE BILL NO. 624 RELATING TO AGRICULTURE

Chairperson Gabbard and Members of the Committee:

Thank for the opportunity to testify on Senate Bill 624, which proposes to develop a strategic plan that identifies benchmarks for increased food production in Hawaii and increased exports of food crops and value-added products from Hawaii. The Department supports the intent of this bill provided it does not impact the department's priorities listed in the Executive Budget and offers comments.

The Department recognizes the importance of metrics in determining local food production in the State. Strategic planning will allow the State to identify attainable goals for the State as it moves into a diversified agricultural economy.
