The Department of Transportation (DOT) **supports** this project and the intent of S.B. 662 with the reservation that the passage of this bill does not replace or adversely impact priorities indicated in our Executive Budget and offer the following comments:

DOT does not appropriate Highways special funds to private individuals and/or businesses submitting a grant-in-aid appropriation request pursuant to Chapter 42F, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The department cannot provide any Highways special funds to assist W.H. Shipman, Ltd. appropriation request to make traffic modifications in the Shipman Business Park on the Island of Hawaii.

If the Legislature appropriates general funds for the grant-in-aid request to W.H. Shipman to be expended by DOT, Highways Division can assist with technical support in the review of design and construction documents created by the grantee. The DOT will oversee the project construction where it encroaches into the State highway right-ofway in accordance with approved documents. The grantee will be responsible for all contracting, expenditures, accounting, and reconciliation of State funds.
