#### SENATE BILL NO. 689 RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL BUILDINGS

Chairperson Tokuda and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on Senate Bill No.689 that authorizes the counties the "implicit right", after giving notice, to enter property to investigated exempted agricultural buildings for violations and compliance with Section 46-88. The Department of Agriculture supports the intent of this measure that promotes active monitoring and enforcement of these exempted structures. In particular, we would point out that exempt structures are required to be "…located on a commercial farm or ranch and are used for general agricultural or aquacultural purposes…" (Bill, page 2 lines 4-8). If this fundamental requirement does not exist, the exempt agricultural building should not be permitted.
