SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 90 URGING THE OFFICE OF PLANNING TO UPDATE THE HAWAII STATE PLANNING ACT'S ECONOMIC OBJECTIVES FOR AGRICULTURE.

Chairperson Gabbard and Members of the Committee:

Thank you for the opportunity to testify on S.C.R. No. 90. This resolution requests the Office of Planning to work with the Department of Agriculture to realign the Hawaii State Planning Act's agricultural priorities to reflect a long-term vision of sustainable agriculture and self-sufficiency in Hawaii. (page 2, lines 10-14). The Department of Agriculture offers comments and a proposed amendment.

We support possible updates to Section 226-7, "objectives and policies for the economy – agriculture", that are related to the cessation of sugarcane cultivation and the decline of pineapple cultivation across the State. We are concerned about being given the elements of the long-term vision, sustainable agriculture and self-sufficiency, from which we are to realign and update the objectives and policies for agriculture. We recommend that the Office of Planning and the Department of Agriculture be also tasked to consider appropriate elements of a long-term vision.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Planning is requested to submit <u>a long-term vision statement and</u> an updated priority list of state economic objectives and policies for agriculture to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2018; and"
