A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EPIDEMIOLOGISTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. During the regular session of 2017, the
- 2 legislature appropriated moneys to the department of health to
- 3 establish an eleventh epidemiologist position. However, section
- 4 321-4.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, limits the director of health
- 5 to establishing only up to ten permanent or temporary positions
- 6 for epidemiologists, without regard to chapter 76, Hawaii
- 7 Revised Statutes.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to amend section 321-4.3, Hawaii
- 9 Revised Statutes, to provide the director of health with greater
- 10 operational flexibility.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 321-4.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- "[+] §321-4.3[+] Epidemiologists. The department of health
- 14 may establish [up to ten] permanent or temporary exempt
- 15 positions known as epidemiologists for the purpose of
- 16 investigating diseases and injuries which threaten the public

- 1 health and safety. The positions shall be appointed by the
- 2 director without regard to chapter 76."
- 3 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
