## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CITATIONS FOR MOTOR VEHICLE REPAIR VIOLATIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 437B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§437B- Citation for licensee violations; fines. (a)		
5	In addition to any other remedy available under this chapter,		
6	the department may issue a citation to any person who holds a		
7	motor vehicle repair dealer or motor vehicle mechanic license		
8	for any of the following violations of this chapter or the rules		
9	adopted pursuant to this chapter and chapter 91:		
10	(1) Failure of a motor vehicle repair dealer to		
11	conspicuously display the dealer's licensure		
12	certificate or certification certificate in the		
13	dealer's place of business;		
14	(2) Failure of a motor vehicle repair dealer to		
15	conspicuously place a board-approved sign in all the		
16	dealer's motor vehicle repair locations; or

1	(3)	Failure of a motor vehicle mechanic to carry or have
2		readily available for inspection the pocket card
3		provided to the motor vehicle mechanic by the
4		department.
5	(b)	Each citation:
6	(1)	Shall be in writing and describe the basis of the
7		citation, including the specific statute or rule
8		violated;
9	(2)	May contain an order of abatement and the assessment
10		of a fine in the amount of \$250 for each violation by
11		a motor vehicle repair dealer and a fine in the amount
12		of \$100 for each violation by a motor vehicle
13		mechanic;
14	(3)	Shall be served on the licensee by personal service;
15		and
16	(4)	Shall inform the licensee that the licensee may submit
17		a written request to the board or its designee for a
18		hearing to contest the citation, within twenty
19		calendar days from the service of the citation.
20	(c)	If the licensee timely submits a written request to
<b>)</b> 1	the beard	or its designed for a hearing the beard may designate

- 1 a hearings officer to conduct the hearing in accordance with
- 2 chapter 91.
- 3 (d) If the licensee does not timely submit a written
- 4 request to the board or its designee for a hearing, the citation
- 5 shall be deemed a final order of the board.
- 6 (e) Failure of a licensee to pay any assessed fine within
- 7 thirty calendar days, unless the licensee contests the citation,
- 8 may result in further disciplinary action taken by the board."
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 10 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 11 begun before its effective date.
- 12 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
