## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS FOR THE NUUANU HYDROELECTRICITY PROJECT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Nuuanu reservoir #4 is an essential component
  in the Nuuanu hydroelectricity project, which will connect
  existing reservoirs in Nuuanu valley to generate renewable
- 4 hydroelectric energy, provide energy storage of off-peak solar
- 5 or wind energy supplies, and supplement usable groundwater
- 6 supplies through the increase of groundwater recharge of
- 7 captured stormwater. Nuuanu reservoir #4 needs to be upgraded
- 8 to facilitate this project. The legislature finds that part
- 9 XII, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, permits the State to
- 10 assist dam and reservoir owners.
- 11 The legislature finds and declares that the issuance of
- 12 special purpose revenue bonds under this Act is in the public
- 13 interest and for the public health, safety, and general welfare.
- 14 SECTION 2. Pursuant to part XII, chapter 39A, Hawaii
- 15 Revised Statutes, the department of budget and finance, with the
- 16 approval of the governor, is authorized to issue special purpose
- 17 revenue bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$6,400,000, in one

- 1 or more series, for the purpose of assisting the Honolulu board
- 2 of water supply, a municipal water utility, to upgrade Nuuanu
- 3 reservoir #4 to meet state dam safety standards as part of the
- 4 Nuuanu hydroelectricity project. The legislature hereby finds
- 5 and determines that Nuuanu reservoir #4 constitutes a project as
- 6 defined in part XII, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and
- 7 the financing thereof is assistance to dam and reservoir owners.
- 8 SECTION 3. The special purpose revenue bonds and the
- 9 refunding special purpose revenue bonds issued under this Act
- 10 shall be issued pursuant to part XII, chapter 39A, Hawaii
- 11 Revised Statutes, relating to the power to issue special purpose
- 12 revenue bonds to assist dam and reservoir owners.
- 13 SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is
- 14 authorized, from time to time, including times subsequent to
- 15 June 30, 2023, to issue special purpose revenue bonds in
- 16 whatever principal amounts the department shall determine to be
- 17 necessary to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized
- 18 in section 2 and to refund special purpose revenue bonds
- 19 authorized in this section, regardless of whether the
- 20 outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special
- 21 purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of

- 1 redemption or whether the refunding special purpose revenue
- 2 bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project programs described in
- 3 section 2. In making this determination, the department shall
- 4 comply with federal law relating to the exemption from federal
- 5 income taxation of the interest on bonds of the nature
- 6 authorized by this section.
- 7 SECTION 5. The authorization to issue special purpose
- 8 revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on June 30, 2023.
- 9 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
