A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTIO	ON 1. Section 141-12.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 17 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year $[\frac{2017-2018}{2018-}]$
- 18 2019 for the food safety certification costs grant program of
- 19 the department of agriculture.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 21 agriculture for the purposes of this Act."

- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 29, 2018.
