STATE OF HAWAII

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 353-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 3 "§353-14 Cash furnished discharged committed person, when.
- 4 (a) Upon the discharge or parole of any committed person who
- 5 has undergone a commitment or sentence of more than one year,
- 6 the committed person may be furnished by the Hawaii paroling
- 7 authority, in its discretion, with funds of not more than \$200,
- 8 to meet the committed person's immediate needs [-]; provided that
- 9 legislative appropriations for this specific purpose have been
- 10 authorized and allocated to the authority. The expenditures
- 11 made by the Hawaii paroling authority shall be included among
- 12 the accounts for cost and maintenance of committed persons.
- (b) The Hawaii paroling authority shall not use any moneys
- 14 appropriated pursuant to subsection (a) for any purpose other
- 15 than to meet a committed person's immediate needs."
- 16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed.
- 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
