A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ORGANIZATIONAL REPORTS OF CANDIDATE COMMITTEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 11-322, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	The candidate committee organizational report shall
4	include:	
5	(1)	The committee's name and address, including web page
6		address, if any;
7	(2)	The candidate's name, address, and telephone number;
8	(3)	The office being sought by the candidate, district,
9		and party affiliation;
10	(4)	The chairperson's name and address and, if appointed,
11		the deputy chairperson's name and address;
12	(5)	The treasurer's name and address and, if appointed,
13		all deputy treasurers' names and addresses;
14	(6)	The name and address of each depository institution in
15		which the committee will maintain any of its accounts
16		and the applicable account number; and
17	(7)	A certification by the candidate and treasurer of the
18		statements in the organizational report[; and

1	(8) The name and address of each contributor who
2	contributed an aggregate amount of more than \$100 to
3	the candidate committee since the last election
4	applicable to the office being sought and the amount
5	and date of deposit of each such contribution]."
5	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
3	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
