## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONFIDENTIAL PERSONAL INFORMATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 708-800, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending the definition of "confidential personal
- 3 information" to read as follows:
- 4 ""Confidential personal information" means information in
- 5 which an individual has a significant privacy interest,
- 6 including but not limited to [a] an individual's entire driver's
- 7 license number[ a] or social security number[ an]; the entire
- 8 identifying number of [a] an individual's depository,
- 9 <u>investment, or credit</u> account[, a bank account number, a
- 10 password or other information that is used for accessing
- 11 information, or any other name, number, or code that is used,
- 12 alone or in conjunction with other information, to confirm the
- 13 identity of a person.]; an individual's entire credit card
- 14 number; or a username and password that, when used in
- 15 conjunction, provide access to an individual's credit card
- 16 account, medical records, or depository, investment, or credit
- 17 account."



- 1 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 2 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 3 begun before its effective date.
- 4 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
