## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the exceptional tree
- 2 act, Act 105, Session Laws of Hawaii 1975, recognizes the value
- 3 of trees for their beauty and ecological functions and requires
- 4 each county to establish a county arborist advisory committee to
- 5 recommend regulations to protect trees of exceptional stature.
- 6 The legislature also finds that section 58-2, Hawaii Revised
- 7 Statutes, requires one member of the county arborist advisory
- 8 committee to be actively employed in the practice of landscape
- 9 architecture. The county of Hawaii currently has only three
- 10 landscape architects working within the county, thereby severely
- 11 limiting the pool of candidates. As a result, the county of
- 12 Hawaii has not had a functioning county arborist advisory
- 13 committee since 2008.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to expand the candidate pool for
- 15 membership on a county arborist advisory committee by including,
- 16 in addition to persons actively employed in landscape
- 17 architecture, certified arborists, horticulturalists with

3	SECT	ION 2. Section 58-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended to read as follows:

8	be appoin	ted by the mayor and shall include [the]:
