## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO YOUTH SUICIDE PREVENTION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Maui county has the
- 2 highest rate of youth suicide attempts in the State and has
- 3 become a serious concern for the community and State overall.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support
- 5 youth suicide early intervention, prevention, and education
- 6 initiatives in Maui county.
- 7 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$25,000 or so much
- 9 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to support
- 10 youth suicide early intervention, prevention, and education
- 11 initiatives in Maui county that focus upon, but are not limited
- 12 to, persons between the ages of ten and twenty-four.
- 13 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 14 health for purposes of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
