A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 134, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§134- Bump fire stock, multiburst trigger activator, or
- 5 trigger crank; prohibition. (a) Any person in this State who
- 6 manufactures or causes to be manufactured, imports into the
- 7 State, keeps for sale, or offers or exposes for sale, or who
- 8 gives, lends, or possesses any bump fire stock, multiburst
- 9 trigger activator, or trigger crank shall be guilty of a class C
- 10 felony.
- 11 (b) As used in this section:
- 12 "Bump fire stock" means a butt stock designed to be
- 13 attached to a semiautomatic firearm and designed, made, or
- 14 altered to increase the rate of fire achievable with such
- 15 firearm by using energy from the recoil of the firearm to
- 16 generate a reciprocating action that facilitates repeated
- 17 activation of the trigger.



1	"Mul	tiburst trigger activator" means:
2	(1)	A device that simulates automatic gunfire by allowing
3		standard function of a semiautomatic firearm with a
4		static positioned trigger finger or a device that
5		fires multiple shots with the pull and release of the
6		trigger; or
7	(2)	A manual or power-driven trigger activating device
8		constructed and designed so that when attached to a
9		semiautomatic firearm it simulates automatic gunfire.
10	<u>"Tri</u>	gger crank" means any device to be attached to a
11	semiautomatic firearm that repeatedly activates the trigger of	
12	the firearm through the use of a lever or other part that is	
13	turned in a circular motion, but does not include any firearm	
14	initially designed and manufactured to fire through the use of a	
15	crank or lever."	
16	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.	
17	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
