SECTION 1. Section 397-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

 equipment" to read as follows:

""Elevators and kindred equipment" as used in this chapter
means elevators, escalators, dumbwaiters, moving walks, stage
lifts, [mechanized parking elevators, manlifts,] inclined lifts,
personnel hoists, [aerial tramways,] permanently installed
material lifts, [personal automatic trains] and any other
similar mechanized equipment used to convey people in places
other than a public right-of-way."

SECTION 2. Section 397-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

"(c) Effective July 1, 2012, the fees for inspections,
permits, and examinations of boilers, pressure systems,
elevators, kindred equipment, and amusement rides shall be as
prescribed by the schedules in this section; provided that the
