SECTION 1. Section 286-208, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 repealed. 3 [" §286-208 ] Exemptions, vehicles used by farmers. This 4 part shall not apply to motor vehicles used by a farmer 5 exclusively for the farmer's farm operations or to motor 6 vehicles used by a farmer who only infrequently transports from 7 the place of production to a warehouse, regular market, place of 8 storage, or place of shipment, the farm products of neighboring 9 farmers in exchange for like or reciprocal services, for farm 10 products, or for a cash consideration not exceeding \$1,500 per 11 year; provided that the transportation of farm produce shall **12** constitute the sole transportation of property for hire or **13** compensation and; provided further that each motor vehicle so 14 used complies with the safety ordinances and rules of the county 15 in which it is operated and other applicable state safety laws 16 and rules. "]

PURPOSE:

To repeal the law relating to exemption for vehicles designated as farm use only as set forth in 286-208, Hawaii Revised Statutes

(HRS).

MEANS:

Repeal section 286-208, HRS.

JUSTIFICATION:

The current State law as set forth in section 286-208, HRS, is outdated and superseded by the Federal regulatory requirements as set forth in 49 CFR 390.5 and 390.39, adopted by the State of Hawaii via Hawaii Administrative Rule chapter 19-141, defining and implementing the vehicle exemption category called "covered farm vehicle." Allowing the current statute to stand will result in a conflict in this area of the law, and given that the State of Hawaii must enact the "covered farm vehicle exemption" as required under Public Law 112-141 (Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21 Century Act), it is prudent for the State of Hawaii to repeal section 286-208.

Impact on the public: Those members of the public who currently have farm exemptions as set forth under section 286-208, HRS, will need to work with HDOT to obtain new exemptions for "covered farm vehicles." Time and effort to do so will be the same as the current farm exemption program under the Motor Vehicle Safety Office expends.

Impact on the department and other agencies: No anticipated impact on other agencies.
