# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREWORKS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 132D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§132D- Liability of property owner. A property owner
- 5 who knowingly allows an individual to possess, set off, ignite,
- 6 or otherwise cause to explode any aerial device while on the
- 7 owner's property shall be deemed to be in violation of this
- 8 chapter and shall be subject to the penalties as specified in
- 9 section 132D-14(a)(2)."
- 10 SECTION 2. Section 132D-20, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended to read as follows:
- "§132D-20 Enforcement[-]; probable cause for arrest. (a)
- 13 This chapter shall be enforced by each county. The counties are
- 14 authorized to enforce and administer the provisions of this
- 15 chapter.
- (b) Arrests for offenses under this chapter or under a
- 17 county fireworks ordinance shall be made in compliance with

1	chapter 803. Probable cause for the arrests may be established
2	based on:
3	(1) Statements from individuals who witnessed the offense,
4	even if those individuals are not law enforcement
5	officers; and
6	(2) Photographs, video recordings, or other recordings
7	that show the commission of the offense and can be
8	authenticated by one or more witnesses."
9	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
10	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
11	begun before its effective date.
12	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on October 1, 2018.

Fireworks; Property Owner Liability; Arrests; Probable Cause

#### Description:

Establishes property owner liability for illegal aerial devices possessed or set off on their property by others. Allows probable cause for fireworks offenses to be established from statements from witnesses and photographs, video, and other recordings authenticated by witnesses. Takes effect on October 1, 2018. (SD2)
