# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 13D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:  
3           "§13D-2 Qualifications of board members. No person shall  
4 be eligible for election or appointment to the board unless the  
5 person is Hawaiian and is:  
6           (1) ~~[qualified]~~ Qualified and registered to vote under the  
7 provisions of section 13D-3 ~~[and]~~;  
8           (2) ~~[where residency on a particular island is a~~  
9 ~~requirement, a]~~ A resident on the island for which  
10 seat the person is seeking election or appointment [-],  
11 if residency on a particular island is a requirement;  
12 and  
13           (3) Not registered as a lobbyist within one year of filing  
14 nomination papers.  
15 No member of the board shall hold or be a candidate for any  
16 other public office under the state or county governments in  
17 accordance with Article II, section 7 of the Constitution of the



1 State; nor shall a person be eligible for election or  
2 appointment to the board if that person is also a candidate for  
3 any other public office under the state or county governments.  
4 The term "public office", for purposes of this section, shall  
5 not include notaries public, reserve police officers, or  
6 officers of emergency organizations for civilian defense or  
7 disaster, or disaster relief."

8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
