
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN AFFAIRS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The Ala Loa trail system historically provided
2 overland transportation and communication within the Hawaiian
3 kingdom. The extensive trail system provided a network for
4 accessing fishing grounds, traversing from community to
5 community, gathering medicine, and other native Hawaiian
6 traditional and cultural practices.

7 SECTION 2. The department of land and natural resources
8 shall recognize the entire Ala Loa trail on the island of Kauai
9 as a state trail. The department shall define the physical
10 boundaries of the Ala Loa trail.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
