A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS TO ADDRESS HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the coordinated 2 statewide homeless initiative provides important, cost-effective 3 homelessness prevention and rapid rehousing services statewide 4 and increases coordination through the statewide information and 5 referral system on behalf of homeless individuals and those at 6 risk of homelessness. In approximately eight months, the 7 initiative provided financial assistance to 1,279 households, 8 thereby assisting 3,992 adults and children who were homeless or 9 at risk of becoming homeless. 10 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate
- moneys to continue and improve the coordinated statewide
 homeless initiative to prevent homelessness and rehouse homeless
 people in the State.
- SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$3,500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year

8			house of representatives and senate committees on
9			housing and human services, respectively;
10		(E)	Develop reporting procedures and timelines for
11			providing performance information to respective
12			state agencies; and
13		(F)	Be accountable for funds expended;
14	(3)	Admi	nistrative fees of fifteen per cent shall be taken
15		in t	otal from the state grant; and
16	(4)	The	total sum of funding shall be provided at the
17		star	t of the coordinated statewide homeless initiative
18		prog	ram to be managed by the master contractor;
19	provided	furth	er that any contracts executed and using the
20	appropriations authorized pursuant to this Act shall not be
