A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE IMPORTANT AGRICULTURAL LAND QUALIFIED AGRICULTURAL COST TAX CREDIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to extend by ten
- 2 years the important agricultural land qualified agricultural
- 3 cost tax credit that will expire in the 2017 tax year. This
- 4 additional time is to allow landowners and farmers to claim the
- 5 tax credit in the event that their agricultural lands are
- 6 identified as potential important agricultural lands and
- 7 designated as such by the land use commission.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 235-110.93, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:
- 10 "(1) The department of agriculture shall cease certifying
- 11 credits pursuant to this section after the [fourth] fourteenth
- 12 taxable year following the taxable year during which the credits
- 13 are first claimed; provided that a taxpayer with accumulated,
- 14 but unclaimed, certified credits may continue claiming the
- 15 credits in subsequent taxable years until exhausted."



- 1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
