

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE EDUCATION OF HOMELESS YOUTH.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 302A-406, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to as follows:
- 3 "§302A-406 Transportation of school children. (a) The
- 4 department may provide suitable transportation to and from
- 5 school and for educational field trips for all children in
- 6 grades kindergarten to twelve and in special education classes.
- 7 The department shall adopt policies, procedures, and programs as
- 8 it deems necessary to provide suitable transportation.
- 9 (b) The department shall provide suitable transportation to
- 10 and from school for all children who are identified as homeless
- 11 as provided in title 42 United States Code sections 11431 -
- 12 11435, commonly known as the McKinney-Vento Act, the department
- 13 shall provide transportation to and from school for homeless
- 14 students at the request of any homeless service provider.
- 15 [\(\frac{(b)}{}\)] (c) The department shall adopt rules under chapter 91
- 16 governing the supervision and administration of the
- 17 transportation of school children under this section."
