

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many schools
 2 restrict or prohibit department of education employees from
 3 distributing information on community sponsored after-school
- 4 programs. The legislature further finds that these restrictions
- 5 and policies serve to isolate schools and conflict with the goal
- 6 that each school be an integral part of its community.
- 7 The purpose of this Act is to allow for the reasonable
- ${f 8}$ promotion of community-sponsored after-school programs by
- ${f 9}$ department of education employees.
- 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
- 12 designated and to read as follows:
- "§302A- After-school programs; promotion. Any employee
- 14 of the department may voluntarily promote a community-sponsored
- 15 after-school program by making announcements, posting notices,
- and communicating information of the after-school program;
- 17 provided that:

1	(1)	The after-school program and the promotional efforts
2		have been approved by the principal; and
3	(2)	The promotion does not impose an unreasonable added
4		workload on the employee.
5	(d)	Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, no
6	employee	of the department shall be liable for any claim arising
7	out of the employee's promotion of a community-sponsored after-	
8	school program pursuant to this section."	
9	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.	
10	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its Approval.
