# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that many schools SECTION 1. 2 restrict or prohibit department of education employees from 3 distributing information on community-sponsored after-school 4 programs. These restrictions and policies serve to isolate 5 schools and conflict with the goal that each school be an 6 integral part of its community. 7 The purpose of this Act is to allow for the reasonable 8 promotion of community-sponsored after-school programs by 9 department of education employees. 10 SECTION 2. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 11 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately 12 designated and to read as follows: 13 "§302A- Community-sponsored after-school programs; 14 promotion. An employee of the department of education may 15 voluntarily promote a community-sponsored after-school program

by making announcements, posting notices, and communicating

information about the after-school program; provided that:

12	SECT	ION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2051.
