3 Only one permit per year shall be required for a youth sports
4 coach who coaches multiple teams.

5 (b) The department shall adopt rules pursuant to chapter
6 91 that establish requirements for youth sports coaches that
7 include:

- 8 (1) Training requirements;
- 9 (2) Cardiopulmonary resuscitation and first aid training
10 requirements;
- 11 (3) Concussion education requirements; and
- 12 (4) Background checks.

13 § -3 **Permit; fees.** Any person desiring the permit
14 required by section -2 shall apply to the department for a
15 permit on a form and in a manner prescribed by the department.
16 The permit shall be valid for one year. The department may
17 charge a reasonable permit processing fee.

18 § -4 **Civil penalties.** Any person who violates any
19 provision of this chapter or the rules adopted by the department
20 pursuant to this chapter shall be fined not more than \$1,000.

1 Each day of continued violation or failure to comply under this
2 chapter shall constitute a separate offense.

3 Unless otherwise expressly provided, the remedies or
4 penalties provided in this chapter are cumulative to each other
5 and to the remedies or penalties available under all other laws
6 of this State."

7 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
9 begun before its effective date.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
