

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CROSSWALKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) There is established within the department
- 2 of transportation a community crosswalks pilot program, which
- 3 shall design and implement a specially painted crosswalk that
- 4 represents a neighborhood's unique culture and promotes
- 5 pedestrian safety.
- 6 (b) The department shall designate a crosswalk within the
- 7 Waipahu school complex area to be used for the pilot program,
- 8 provided that the crosswalk:
- 9 (1) Must be at a location that is already a marked
- 10 crosswalk, and where a vehicle is required to stop,
- either due to a stop sign or traffic signal;
- 12 (2) To the extent possible, shall be located at an
- intersection with shorter width between streets and
- 14 that experiences lower traffic volume; and
- 15 (3) Is located on pavement that is in good condition.
- 16 (c) The design of the crosswalk shall comply with the
- 17 following quidelines:



1	(1)	The crosswark design must include two white norizontal
2		markings with standard design and reflectivity to mark
3		the edges of the crosswalk and ensure it meets minimum
4		standards as required by state and county law;
5	(2)	The crosswalk design must be fully contained within
6		the two white horizontal markings;
7	(3)	The design must use only horizontal or vertical
8		stripes to ensure people driving, walking, and biking
9		are aware that the specially painted crosswalk is an
10		official crosswalk and is a designated place for
11		people to cross;
12	(4)	Colors for the crosswalk shall be approved by the
13		department; and
14	(5)	No text or logos, or octagons, triangles, or other
15		symbols shall be used.
16	(d)	Once a design is approved by the department, the
17	departmen	t shall work in coordination with the department of
18	transport	ation services of the city and county of Honolulu to
19	apply the	approved design to the designated crosswalk.

- 1 (e) There is established a community crosswalks special
- 2 fund to be administered by the department of transportation for
- 3 the purposes of this section, into which shall be deposited:
- 4 (1) All moneys appropriated by the legislature;
- 5 (2) Moneys withdrawn from the safe routes to school
- 6 program special fund established under section 291C-4,
- 7 Hawaii Revised Statutes; and
- **8** (3) Gifts and other private funds.
- 9 The community crosswalks special fund shall be abolished on
- 10 June 30, 2019, and all unencumbered balances shall lapse to the
- 11 credit of the general fund.
- 12 (f) The department shall submit a report of its
- 13 activities, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 14 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 15 the regular sessions of 2018 and 2019.
- 16 SECTION 2. Section 291C-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 17 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 18 "(a) There is established in the state treasury the safe
- 19 routes to school program special fund, into which shall be
- **20** deposited:

1	(1)	Assessments collected for speeding in a school zone,	
2	1	pursuant to section 291C-104; and	
3	(2)	Safe routes to school program surcharges collected in	
4		accordance with sections 291-16 and 291C-5.	
5	Moneys in	the fund shall be:	
6	(1)	[distributed] Distributed by the director of	
7		transportation to the respective counties to	
8	•	expend[+]; and	
9	(2)	Used for the community crosswalks pilot program	
10	<u>.</u>	established by Act , Session Laws of Hawaii 2017."	
11	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
12	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much		
13	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the		
14	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
15	2018-2019 for deposit into the community crosswalks pilot		
16	program special fund established under section 1 of this Act.		
17	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the safe routes to		
18	school program special fund established under section 291C-4,		
19	Hawaii Revised Statutes, the sum of \$ or so much thereof		
20	as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the same sum		
21	or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019		

- 1 for deposit into the community crosswalks pilot program special
- 2 fund established under section 1 of this Act.
- 3 There is appropriated out of the community
- 4 crosswalks pilot program special fund the sum of \$ or so
- 5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and
- 6 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
- 7 year 2018-2019 for the purposes of the community crosswalk pilot
- 8 program established by section 1 of this Act.
- 9 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- **10** of transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017, and
- 14 shall be repealed on June 30, 2019, provided that section 291C-
- 15 4(a), Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in
- 16 which it read on the day prior to the effective date of this
- 17 Act.
