RELATING TO TRAFFIC SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part XII to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§291C- Exiting a stopped or standing vehicle on a
- 5 roadway; prohibited. (a) No person operating a vehicle that is
- 6 stopped or standing, or passenger of that vehicle that is
- 7 stopped or standing, on any roadway shall exit the vehicle and
- 8 confront the driver or passenger of another stopped or standing
- 9 vehicle.
- (b) As used in this section, "confront" means to use
- 11 offensive or threatening gestures, shouting obscenities,
- 12 throwing projectiles at a vehicle, or physically touching the
- 13 vehicle to cause an occupant of that vehicle to fear imminent
- 14 serious bodily injury."
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun before its effective date.


