A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE CONTRACTORS LICENSE BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 444-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended to	o read as follows:
3	"§44	4-3 Contractors license board. (a) There shall be a
4	contracto	rs license board [ef] comprising thirteen members.
5	(b)	Of the board members:
6	(1)	Ten shall be contractors who have been actively
7		engaged in the contracting business for a period of
8		[not less] no fewer than [five] ten years preceding
9		the date of their appointment[+
10	(2)]	and who hold a valid and unexpired license to operate
11		as a contractor at the time of appointment. Of the
12		ten contractors:
13		(A) Five shall be general engineering contractors or
14		general building contractors[, five]; and
15		(B) Five shall be specialty contractors[, and three
16		shall be noncontractors.]; provided that two
17		shall hold a general engineering or general

1	contractors license and three shall not hold a	
2	general engineering or general contractors	
3	license; and	
4	(2) Three shall be public members who, at the time of	
5	appointment, do not hold a valid or unexpired license	
6	to operate as a contractor, do not have any family	
7	member who is a licensee, and do not have any	
8	financial interest in the business of any licensee of	
9	the board.	
10	(c) No member shall receive any compensation for the	
11	member's services, but each shall be reimbursed for necessary	
12	[traveling] travel expenses incurred in the performance of	
13	duties.	
14	$[\frac{(c)}{(c)}]$ Each county shall be represented on the board.	
15	[(d) No one, except the three noncontractor members, shall	
16	be eligible for appointment who does not at the time of the	
17	member's appointment hold a valid and unexpired license to	
18	operate as a contractor.]	
19	(e) For the purposes of this section, the terms "general	
20	engineering contractor", "general building contractor", and	

- 1 "specialty contractor" shall have the meanings given to them in
- 2 section 444-7."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000;
- 6 provided that the current members of the contractors license
- 7 board shall serve in their respective capacities until their
- 8 replacements are appointed by the governor.
