#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 387-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: Notwithstanding the provisions of section 387-2, the 3 "(a) director [may], by rule, may provide for the employment: 4 5 Of learners, of apprentices, of part-time employees (1)6 who are full-time students attending public or private schools other than colleges, universities, business 7 schools, or technical schools, and of wards paroled 8 from the Hawaii youth correctional facility, under 9 special certificates issued by the director, at [such] 10 wages lower than the applicable minimum wage and 11 12 subject to [such] limitations as to time, number, 13 proportion, and length of service [as] that the 14 director [shall prescribe;] prescribes; and Of [individuals whose earning capacity is impaired by 15 (2) old age or physical or mental deficiency or injury,] 16
