## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE MINIMUM WAGE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 387-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	Notwithstanding the provisions of section 387-2, the
4	director	[may], by rule, may provide for the employment[+
5	<del>(1)</del>	$\Theta$ f] of learners, of apprentices, of part-time
6		employees who are full-time students attending public
7		or private schools other than colleges, universities,
8		business schools, or technical schools, and of wards
9		paroled from the Hawaii youth correctional facility,
10		under special certificates issued by the director, at
11		[such] wages lower than the applicable minimum wage
12		and subject to [such] limitations as to time, number,
13		proportion, and length of service as the director
14		shall prescribe[; and
15	<del>(2)</del>	Of individuals whose carning capacity is impaired by
16	·	old age or physical or mental deficiency or injury,
17		under special certificates issued by the director, at

1	such wages lower than the applicable minimum wage and		
2	for such period as shall be fixed in the		
3	<del>certificates</del> ]."		
4	SECTION 2. The department of labor and industrial relations		
5	shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations,		
6	including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later		
7	than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session		
8	of 2019 and each regular session thereafter relating to		
9	sustainable employment opportunities of individuals working at		
10	subminimum wage prior to the effective date of this measure and		
11	efforts by the department to increase employment opportunities		
12	for individuals with disabilities.		
13	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
14	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so		
15	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for		
16	one full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) inspection and enforcement		
17	position within the wage standards division of the department of		
18	labor and industrial relations.		
19	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
20	labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.		

- 1 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
