

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BICYCLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 291C-145, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

 "(c) Whenever a usable bicycle lane has been provided on
- 3 "(c) Whenever a usable bicycle lane has been provided on a
- 4 highway, any person operating a bicycle [at a speed less than
- 5 the normal speed of traffic moving in the same direction at such
- 6 time] shall ride within [such] the bicycle lane, except that
- 7 [such] the person may move out of the lane under any of the
- 8 following situations:
- 9 (1) When overtaking and passing another bicycle, vehicle,
 10 or pedestrian within the lane or about to enter the
 11 lane if [such] overtaking and passing cannot be done
 12 safely within the lane;
- (2) When preparing for a left turn at an intersection orinto a private road or driveway; or
- (3) When reasonably necessary to leave the bicycle lane toavoid debris or other hazardous conditions.

6	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
7	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
8	begun before its effective date.

10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
