## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BICYCLES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 291C-145, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:
3	"(c) Whenever a usable bicycle lane has been provided on a
4	highway, any person operating a bicycle [at a speed less than
5	the normal speed of traffic moving in the same direction at such
6	time] shall ride within [such] the bicycle lane, except that
7	[such] the person may move out of the lane under any of the
8	following situations:
9	(1) When overtaking and passing another bicycle, vehicle,
10	or pedestrian within the lane or about to enter the
11	lane if [such] overtaking and passing cannot be done
12	safely within the lane;
13	(2) When preparing for a left turn at an intersection or
14	into a private road or driveway; or
15	(3) When reasonably necessary to leave the bicycle lane to
16	avoid debris or other hazardous conditions.

3	SECT	ION 2	. Section 291C-148, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4	amended by	y ame	nding subsection (b) to read as follows:

7	sidewalk a	area;	provided that [the]:
8	(1)	The ·	driver of the bicycle shall yield the right-of-way

12	(3)	When	ever a usable bicycle lane is available, the
13		driv	er of the bicycle shall ride within that bicycle
14		lane	, except that the driver may move out of the

16		(A)	When overtaking and passing another bicycle,

18			to enter the lane if overtaking and passing
19			cannot be done safely within the lane;

1	(C) When reasonably necessary to leave the bicycle
2	lane to avoid debris or other hazardous
3	conditions.
4	Any person in violation of this subsection shall be fined
5	not more than \$ per violation."
6	SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
7	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
8	begun before its effective date.
9	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
