A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD SAFETY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWA'II:

SECTION 1. Section 350-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§350-2 Action on reporting. (a) Upon receiving a report
4 concerning child abuse or neglect, the department shall proceed
5 pursuant to chapter 587A and the department's rules.

6 (b) The department shall inform the appropriate police 7 department of all reports received by the department regarding a 8 case of child abuse or neglect, including reports received under 9 section 350-1.1; provided that the name of the person who 10 reported the case of child abuse or neglect shall be released to 11 the police department pursuant only to court order or the 12 person's consent.

(c) The department shall inform the appropriate police department or office of the prosecuting attorney of the relevant information concerning a case of child abuse or neglect when the information is required by the police department or the office of the prosecuting attorney for the investigation or prosecution

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of that case; provided that the name of the person who reported 1 the case of child abuse or neglect shall be released to the 2 police department or the office of the prosecuting attorney 3 4 pursuant only to court order or the person's consent. 5 The department shall maintain a central registry of (d) reported child abuse or neglect cases and shall promptly expunge 6 7 the reports in cases if: 8 The report is determined not confirmed by the (1)department, an administrative hearing officer, or a 9 10 Hawaii state court on appeal; or 11 (2) The petition arising from the report has been dismissed by order of the family court after an 12 adjudicatory hearing on the merits pursuant to chapter 13 14 587A. Records and information contained in a report that is 15 expunded may be retained by the department solely for future 16 17 risk and safety assessment purposes. The department may release the disposition of an 18 (e) assessment from an investigation into an allegation or report of 19 child abuse or neglect that was confirmed by the department and 20 21 occurring within a group child care home or group child care



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1	center licensed pursuant to section 346-163 perpetrated by an
2	agent, employee, or independent contractor of that group child
3	care home or group child care center to any parent or guardian
4	who has submitted an application or request to place a child in
5	the group child care home or group child care center at the time
6	of the alleged abuse or neglect or to a parent or guardian who
7	is considering placing a child in the group child care home or
8	group child care center. Information disclosed pursuant to this
9	subsection shall not contain the names or other identifying
10	information of any individual whose name or other information is
11	otherwise protected from disclosure.
12	(f) The department shall adopt rules as may be necessary
13	in carrying out this section."
14	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
15	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.

Child Abuse; Child Neglect; Reports; Group Child Care Home; Group Child Care Center

Authorizes disclosure of child abuse and neglect reports for incidents occurring in group child care homes or group child care centers to parents or guardians of children enrolled in the home or center at the time of the alleged abuse or neglect or to parents or guardians considering enrolling their children in the home or center.
