

1 years and the term of office of a member of the senate shall be
2 four years. No member of the house of representatives shall
3 serve more than ten terms. No member of the senate shall serve
4 more than five terms. Any person appointed or elected to fill a
5 vacancy in the house of representatives or the senate for a
6 period greater than one half of a term of office shall be
7 considered to have served one term. This limitation on terms
8 shall apply to terms beginning on or after November 6, 2018.

9 The term of a member of the legislature shall begin on the
10 day of the general election at which elected or if elected at a
11 primary election, on the day of the general election immediately
12 following the primary election at which elected. For a member
13 of the house of representatives, the terms shall end on the day
14 of the general election immediately following the day the
15 member's term commences. For a member of the senate, the term
16 shall end on the day of the second general election immediately
17 following the day the member's term commences."

18 SECTION 3. The question to be printed on the ballot shall
19 be as follows:

5 SECTION 5. This amendment shall take effect upon
6 compliance with article XVII, section 3, of the Constitution of
