

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 168, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, section 2, is amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 2 3 An electric vehicle on which an electric vehicle "(b) 4 license plate is affixed shall be exempt from payment of parking 5 fees, including those collected through parking meters, charged 6 by any state or county authority in this State, except that this 7 exemption shall not apply: 8 (1) For more than two and one-half hours of metered 9 parking, or the maximum amount of time the meter 10 allows, whichever is longer; or 11 $[\frac{(2)}{}]$ To parking fees assessed in increments longer than one 12 twenty-four-hour day, including weekly, monthly, or 13 annual parking permits.] 14 (2) For non-metered parking stalls, for any period longer 15 than the initial twenty-four hours of use of the 16 parking stall."
