50 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2015; and 2 (2)3 (3) 75 cents per hour beginning January 1, 2016, 4 below the applicable minimum wage by the employee's employer and 5 the combined amount the employee receives from the employee's 6 employer and in tips is at least 50 cents more than the 7 applicable minimum wage; provided that beginning January 1, 8 2015, the combined amount the employee receives from the 9 employee's employer and in tips is at least \$7.00 more than the 10 applicable minimum wage. 11 On September 30, 2019, and on September 30 of each (C) 12 year thereafter, the department of labor and industrial 13 relations shall calculate an adjusted minimum wage rate. The 14 adjusted minimum wage rate shall be calculated to the nearest 15 cent using the Honolulu region consumer price index for urban wage earners and clerical workers, CPI-W, or a successor index, 16 17 for the twelve months prior to September 1 of each year as 18 calculated by the United States Department of Labor. Each 19 adjusted minimum wage rate calculated under this subsection

20 shall take effect on the following January 1."
