A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATED TO MOTOR VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to part XII to be appropriately		
3	designated and to read as follows:		
4	"§291C- Mauna Kea and Waipio valley access; required		
5	four-wheel drive vehicle use. (a) No vehicle, other than a		
6	low-range, four-wheel drive vehicle, shall at any time be driven		
7	through or in the connecting roadway corridor between the Waipic		
8	valley lookout and the floor of Waipio valley or the connecting		
9	roadway corridor between Hale Pohaku and the Mauna Kea science		
10	reserve; provided that any vehicle may be driven in these areas		
11	<u>if:</u>		
12	(1) It is in the process of executing a legal turn, lane		
13	change, or parking maneuver to exit the area;		
14	(2) It is an authorized emergency vehicle performing the		
15	functions under section 291C-26;		
16	(3) It is an official federal, state, or county vehicle in		
17	the performance of its actual duty;

1	(4)	It is necessary to assist a stalled or broken vehicle;
2	(5)	It is necessary to yield to an authorized emergency
3		vehicle pursuant to section 291C-65;
4	(6)	It is a vehicle engaged in or in support of research
5		or maintenance activities; or
6	(7)	It is otherwise provided by law.
7	(b)	Violation of this section shall subject the driver of
8	the vehic	le to a fine of \$250.
9	For	purposes of this section, an all-wheel drive vehicle
10	shall not	be considered to be a low-range, four-wheel drive
11	vehicle."	
12	SECT	TION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
13	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
14	begun bef	ore its effective date.
15	SECT	ION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECT	'ION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
