

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IDENTIFICATION CARDS FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that persons with
- 2 disabilities want to be able to indicate their disability on
- 3 their identification cards, such as the State of Hawaii
- 4 identification card, driver's license, or an identification card
- 5 for persons with disabilities.
- 6 Because not all disabilities are outwardly visible, the
- 7 disclosure of a disability on a driver's license or
- 8 identification card can assist first responders in determining
- 9 the best way to treat, assist, or communicate with persons with
- 10 disabilities.
- 11 Furthermore, a license or identification card clearly
- 12 indicating a person's disability would allow the person access
- 13 to certain services such as special seating on public transit or
- 14 at public events. The "disabled" notation on the card indicates
- 15 that a person has a disability and does not take the place of
- 16 existing public service qualification procedures.

- 1 To mitigate potential abuse, medical documentation is
- 2 required to support a person's request for indication of a
- 3 disability on that person's identification card.
- 4 The purpose of this Act is to allow persons to include
- 5 information about their disability on their driver's license,
- 6 state identification card, or identification card for persons
- 7 with disabilities.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 286, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 1. By adding a new section to part VI to be appropriately
- 11 designated and to read:
- 12 "§286- Driver's license for persons with disabilities.
- 13 Persons with disabilities may opt to identify their disability
- 14 on their driver's license upon receipt of the required
- 15 documentation from the person requesting its inclusion. The
- 16 driver's license shall display the "disabled" notation on a
- 17 location designated by the department of transportation."
- 18 2. By adding a new section to part XVI to be appropriately
- 19 designated and to read:
- 20 "§286- Identification card for persons with
- 21 disabilities. (a) The department of transportation shall issue



- 1 identification cards to persons with disabilities pursuant to
- 2 section 286-305.
- 3 (b) The identification card for persons with disabilities
- 4 shall include characteristics and content pursuant to section
- 5 286-305. On the reverse side of the identification card shall
- 6 be a space within which the department shall enter the
- 7 disability information that the applicant may request.
- 8 (c) The department may include a notation of disability
- 9 status, if desired by the applicant, on the front and may print
- 10 the disability information on the reverse on any driver's license
- 11 or identification card issued pursuant to this chapter upon
- 12 receipt of the required documentation from the person requesting
- 13 its inclusion.
- 14 (d) Temporary disabilities. An identification card for
- 15 persons with a temporary disability shall be issued upon
- 16 presentation of a sworn affidavit of at least one medical doctor
- 17 attesting to the disability and estimating the duration of the
- 18 disability. Identification cards indicating temporary
- 19 disabilities shall be issued for periods of one year, and a
- 20 current affidavit of a medical doctor attesting to the

- 1 continuance of the disability shall be presented at each request
- 2 thereafter."
- 3 SECTION 3. Section 286-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately
- 5 inserted and to read as follows:
- 6 ""Disability" means any physical, mental, or neurological
- 7 impairment that severely restricts a person's mobility, manual
- 8 dexterity, or ability to climb stairs; substantial loss of sight
- 9 or hearing; loss of one or more limbs or use thereof; or
- 10 significantly diminished reasoning capacity.
- "Person with disabilities" means any person with a
- 12 permanent or temporary disability."
- 13 SECTION 4. Section 286-305, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 "§286-305 Contents and characteristics; form. (a) Each
- 16 identification card issued by the examiner of drivers shall
- 17 display a distinguishing number assigned to the cardholder, and
- 18 shall display the following inscription:
- 19 "STATE OF HAWAII IDENTIFICATION CARD"
- 20 (b) The examiner of drivers, after obtaining the
- 21 fingerprint of the applicant as provided in this part and after



- 1 obtaining the information required by or pursuant to this part,
- 2 shall issue to each applicant an identification card in a form
- 3 and with identifying information that the director deems
- 4 necessary and appropriate, including a notation of veteran
- 5 status, if desired by the applicant, on the front of the card
- 6 where applicable; provided that such notation shall not include
- 7 any designation other than the term "veteran". As used in this
- 8 subsection, "veteran" means any person who served in any of the
- 9 uniformed services of the United States and was discharged under
- 10 conditions other than dishonorable.
- 11 (c) The identification card shall not display the
- 12 cardholder's social security number.
- (d) The identification card shall be designed to prevent
- 14 its reproduction or alteration without ready detection.
- 15 (e) The identification card for individuals under twenty-
- 16 one years of age shall have characteristics prescribed by the
- 17 examiner distinguishing it from that issued to a individual who
- 18 is twenty-one years of age or older.
- 19 (f) Persons with disabilities may opt to identify their
- 20 disability on their identification card upon receipt of the
- 21 required documentation from the person requesting its inclusion.

1 The identification card shall display a notification of 2 disability status, if desired by the applicant, on the front of 3 the card where applicable; except that the notation shall not 4 include any designation other than the term "disabled."" 5 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 7 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 2, 2019. 8 SCON
