A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO UNCONTESTED TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 2 to read as follows: 3 TRANSMITTAL OF TRAFFIC FINES 4 "PART AND FORFEITURES TO COUNTIES 5 §291C-A Definitions. As used in this part, unless the 6 7 context clearly requires otherwise: "Traffic infraction" means the same as defined in section 8 9 291D-2. "Uncontested traffic infraction" means a traffic infraction 10 for which the person issued a notice under section 291D-5 does 11 not contest the infraction. A person "does not contest" an 12 infraction if, in accordance with section 291D-6(b)(1), the 13 person admits the commission of the infraction without 14 requesting a hearing to explain mitigating circumstances and 15 pays or remits bail forfeiture by mail, via the Internet, or by 16 telephone within thirty days. 17

- No county shall be entitled to any portion of the fines and

- 18 SECTION 2. Section 291C-171, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 19 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 20 "(a) All fines and forfeitures collected upon conviction
- 21 or upon the forfeiture of bail of any person charged with a

violation of any section or provision of the state traffic laws 1 and all assessments collected relating to the commission of 2 traffic infractions shall be paid to the director of finance of 3 the State. The judiciary shall identify those fines paid for 4 uncontested traffic infractions as defined in section 291C-A. 5 6 The disposition of fines and forfeitures paid to the director of 7 finance shall be subject to section 291C-B." SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section 8 1 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute 9 appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating 10 the new sections in this Act. 11 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 12
